Duration: 15-18 months

## Who is it for?

A team leader is a first line management role, with operational/project responsibilities or responsibility for managing a team to deliver a clearly defined outcome. They provide direction, instructions and guidance to ensure the achievement of set goals. Key responsibilities are likely to include supporting, managing and developing team members, managing projects, planning and monitoring workloads and resources, delivering operational plans, resolving problems, and building relationships internally and externally.

## What are the ESFA entry requirements?

- Lived in the UK for at least 3 years
- Commitment to doing 6 hours off-the-job-training every week

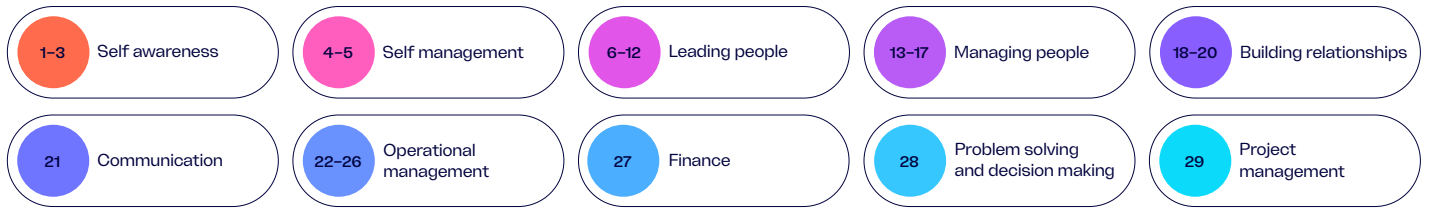

## How is the programme assessed?

Participants will have to go through a series of assessments at the end of the programme. This is known as the End Point Assessment (EPA) which includes:

- Presentation with questions and answers (50%); and
- Professional Discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence (50%).

The EPA pass mark is 50%, and participants can be awarded a Distinction (70%+). Additional assessments are required for CMI qualification.
